Apart from being the greatest philanthropist and human right activist, he was a great champion of Education and has also been awarded with the Nobel Peace Prize.

His passion for education was a result of his own experiences growing up, and later struggling against inequality. Throughout his life and even during his imprisonment, Mandela made sure he educated himself as he believed learning is an escape from his confines. Even a day before his trial at which he could have been served a death sentence, he was writing papers for his law degree. He even inspired his fellow prisoners to do the same.

He spent his entire life, not just educating himself, but also ensuring that his people and every child around the world is provided with the education. There are various institutes that were set up to help provide quality education for children in impoverished rural areas where infrastructure does not support it. One of the foundations of Mandela also partnered up with UNICEF to create Schools for Africa, a campaign to support education initiatives in 13 African countries. Since its commencement in 2005, Schools for Africa has helped over 30 million children receive a better education.

I would like to end my article with a very powerful quote by Sir Mandela that inspired me: **"A winner is a dreamer who never gives up."**




